Employment Recommendations based on Wisconsin Promise Findings:

Based on results from access to benefits counseling:

More funding for Work Incentive Planning and Assistance



Based on results from connecting with Family Advocates:

Invest in a strengthened comprehensive case management for SSI youth that includes supports to families



Based on results from paid youth work experiences:

Transition services for youth with disabilities must include at least two work experiences before exiting high school

Based on results from use of Individual Development Accounts:

Explore the development of funding mechanism to expand the use of youth Individual Development Accounts

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Findings from WI Promise should be featured in a Congressional hearing or briefing on public benefits reform
- Future Social Security Administration demonstration projects must require a systems change focus with specific public policy recommendations for state and federal agencies
