

Save the Date! Joint Finance Committee hearings on the State Budget

The Joint Finance Committee (JFC) will be holding public hearings across the state on the proposed state budget to hear what people think about it in April. Anticipated dates and city locations are as follows:

- Monday, April 3 – Platteville
- Wednesday, April 5 – Milwaukee
- Friday, April 7 – Marinette
- Tuesday, April 18 – Spooner
- Wednesday, April 19 – Ellsworth
- Friday, April 21 – To Be Determined

These hearings are important so that JFC members who will be making changes to the state budget know what is important to people with disabilities.
