

Conference Presentation Proposal Announcement

Are you interested in presenting at the **2021** Self-Determination Conference? We are seeking session proposals for Tuesday, October 19 & Wednesday, October 20, 2021.

This year's theme: Growing Stronger Together will help people with disabilities lead more Self-Determined lives by recognizing the valued role communities play in our lives!

Things to know when submitting a proposal:

- Proposals **must** include a self-advocate(s) as a lead or co-presenter.
- Panels should be limited to no more than 3 people.
- Conference sessions must support Self-Determination and Self-Directed principles.
- Presentations will be in person <u>and</u> on video this year. Activity and tools must be available on both platforms. Presentations should focus on practical, take-home strategies that people can implement in their work and lives.
- Sessions should not promote specific agencies or products.
- Repeat or similar sessions from previous conferences will not be considered.
- Sessions will be 1.5 hours in length.
- A typical session has an audience of 50-75 attendees.

If your session is accepted:

- Handouts: Presenters agree to email a copy of the PowerPoint and other handouts to <u>Fil.Clissa@wisconsin.gov</u> by September 15, 2021. Handouts will be placed on a secured website for conference attendees to access after the conference. You are responsible for providing 50-75 copies of your materials for your session.
- **Equipment:** A Screen, A/V Cart, LCD Projector, laptop, and microphone will be provided in each breakout room. Zoom and internet capacity is also required. Bring your presentation on a flash drive or use your own laptop.
- Presenters <u>must</u> register for the conference.
